October 31st, 2021 - We Can Only Overcome Through God



1 John is clear. God takes false doctrine seriously. In the first century, it was common to describe someone's character by the spirit within them. A jealous person had a "spirit of jealousy" in them. We don't talk that way. It sounds too Ghostbuster-ish for our post-enlightenment minds, but they didn't mean you were overtaken against your will by some demonic spirit of jealousy. It was a description of what kind of spirit you allowed, by your own choice, to rule your life. The Bible uses language like this too. "Their deeds will not allow them to return to their God. For a **spirit of harlotry** is within them, and they

do not know the Lord." (Hosea 5:4). "For you have not received a **spirit of slavery** leading to fear again, but you have received a **spirit of adoption** as sons..." (Romans 8:15)

In the 400 years of silence period, Jews talked a lot about people being influenced either by a spirit of truth or of falsehood. "So understand my children that two spirits await an opportunity with humanity. The spirit of truth and the spirit of error. In between is the conscience of the mind which inclines as it will." (Testament of Judah, 20:1-3). When you understand how common this language was, John's wording in 1 John 4 isn't so strange. He says, "Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world." (1 John 4:1) John knows all of us get to choose which spirit we allow to rule our lives. Will it be an evil, demonic spirit? Or the Holy Spirit of God? John says some teaching clearly originates from evil, Satanic spirits, and the best way to test the spirits is to measure their teaching against the teaching of the Holy Spirit inspired apostles. "We are from God; he who knows God listens to us; he who is not from God does not listen to us. By this we know the spirit of truth and the spirit of error." (1 John 4:6)

I'm preaching a sermon today about a basic way to test the spirits using the apostles' teaching, but for this article I want to point out a key verse in this discussion. "You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world." (1 John 4:4) Often when we think about testing the spirits or defending the faith, it feels overwhelming. We think about big debates with our friends and neighbors, we think about our ability to always have the right answers in the moment, we worry about being misled when we don't know enough, and we worry about awkward conflicts. In short, we make it too much about us.

John says the real reason we can overcome the evil spirits of the world is because the Spirit we have from God is greater than those spirits! The more we lean on God for strength, the more convicted we are about the truth of His Spirit's teachings, the more we ask Him for wisdom to understand His will, the better equipped we'll be to overcome this world full of false teaching from evil spirits. We can't do it on our own. We're not smart enough or strong enough. We must lean fully on God's help to overcome false teaching.

Leaning on Him will also keep us from pride. If we successfully convince a neighbor or friend about the truth of baptism in Scripture, it won't be because we "won" the debate by our own brilliance. It'll be because the Lord was working in us and through us, and we humbly allowed the brilliance of His truth to lead the way. We'll only overcome the false spirits of this world through God.


