The Promise Made

Gen 11:27-32 This is the genealogy of Terah: Terah begot Abram, Nahor, and Haran. Haran begot Lot. 28 And Haran died before his father Terah in his native land, in Ur of the Chaldeans. 29 Then Abram and Nahor took wives: the name of Abram's wife was Sarai, and the name of Nahor's wife, Milcah, the daughter of Haran the father of Milcah and the father of Iscah. 30 But Sarai was barren; she had no child. 31 And Terah took his son Abram and his grandson Lot, the son of Haran, and his daughter-in-law Sarai, his son Abram's wife, and they went out with them from Ur of the Chaldeans to go to the land of Canaan; and they came to Haran and dwelt there. 32 So the days of Terah were two hundred and five years, and Terah died in Haran.

Gen 12:7-9 Then the Lord appeared to Abram and said, "To your descendants I will give this land." And there he built an altar to the Lord, who had appeared to him. 8 And he moved from there to the mountain east of Bethel, and he pitched his tent with Bethel on the west and Ai on the east; there he built an altar to the Lord and called on the name of the Lord. 9 So Abram journeyed, going on still toward the South.
As Abraham traveled the land, God reassured him that all the land he saw would belong to his
The Promise Confirmed
Gen 13:14-18 And the Lord said to Abram, after Lot had separated from him: "Lift your eyes now and look from the place where you are — northward, southward, eastward, and westward; 15 for all the land which you see I give to you and your descendants forever. 16 And I will make your descendants as the dust of the earth; so that if a man could number the dust of the earth, then your descendants also could be numbered. 17 Arise, walk in the land through its length and its width, for I give it to you."
After Abraham and Lot separated God appeared to him again confirming His promise to give him a large and a fertile land.
Gen 15:1-6 After these things the word of the Lord came to Abram in a vision, saying, "Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your exceedingly great reward." 2 But Abram said, "Lord God, what will You give me, seeing I go childless, and the heir of my house is Eliezer of Damascus?" 3 Then Abram said, "Look, You have given me no offspring; indeed one born in my house is my heir!" 4 And behold, the word of the Lord came to him, saying, "This one shall not be your heir, but one who will come from your own body shall be your heir." 5 Then He brought him outside and said, "Look now toward heaven, and count the stars if you are able to number them." And He said to him, "So shall your descendants be." 6 And he believed in the Lord, and He accounted it to him for righteousness.
After Abraham saved Lot, God appeared to him again telling him that Eliezer is not his heir and that the heir God would fulfill the promise through would be Abraham's
son. This time God took Abraham outside and told him his descendants would be like the stars of heaven. They would be number.
Gon 17:5-8 No longer shall your name be called Ahram, but your name shall be Ahraham

Gen 17:5-8 No longer shall your name be called Abram, but your name shall be Abraham; for I have made you a father of many nations. 6 I will make you exceedingly fruitful; and I will make nations of you, and kings shall come from you. 7 And I will establish My covenant

between Me and you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and your descendants after you. 8 Also I give to you and your descendants after you the land in which you are a stranger, all the land of Canaan, as an everlasting possession; and I will be their God."

God confirms His covenant again with Abraham. This time He gives a of the covenant. The sign of the covenant is God also blesses Sarah and tells Abraham that the nation and seed promise would be fulfilled through
Gen 18:10-15 And He said, "I will certainly return to you according to the time of life, are behold, Sarah your wife shall have a son." (Sarah was listening in the tent door which we behind him.) 11 Now Abraham and Sarah were old, well advanced in age; and Sarah have passed the age of childbearing. 12 Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, "After have grown old, shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also?" And the Lord said Abraham, "Why did Sarah laugh, saying, 'Shall I surely bear a child, since I am old?' 14 anything too hard for the Lord? At the appointed time I will return to you, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son." 15 But Sarah denied it, saying, "I did not laugh for she was afraid. And He said, "No, but you did laugh!"
God appears to Abraham again and that the son of promise would come through Sarah. This time Sarah
Gen 26:2-5 Then the Lord appeared to him and said: "Do not go down to Egypt; live in the land of which I shall tell you. 3 Dwell in this land, and I will be with you and bless you; for you and your descendants I give all these lands, and I will perform the oath which I swore Abraham your father. 4 And I will make your descendants multiply as the stars of heaven will give to your descendants all these lands; and in your seed all the nations of the ear shall be blessed; 5 because Abraham obeyed My voice and kept My charge, No commandments, My statutes, and My laws."
God gave the same three part promise to Isaac because of Abraham's
Gen 28:13-15 And behold, the Lord stood above it and said: "I am the Lord God of Abraha your father and the God of Isaac; the land on which you lie I will give to you and yo descendants. 14 Also your descendants shall be as the dust of the earth; you shall spread abroad to the west and the east, to the north and the south; and in you and in your seed at the families of the earth shall be blessed. 15 Behold, I am with you and will keep you wherever you go, and will bring you back to this land; for I will not leave you until I have dornwhat I have spoken to you."
Jacob gets the same promise; through his seed nations would be

blessed.

The Promise Initiated

Gen 21:1-7 And the Lord visited Sarah as He had said, and the Lord did for Sarah as He had spoken. 2 For Sarah conceived and bore Abraham a son in his old age, at the set time of which God had spoken to him. 3 And Abraham called the name of his son who was born to him — whom Sarah bore to him — Isaac. 4 Then Abraham circumcised his son Isaac when he was eight days old, as God had commanded him. 5 Now Abraham was one hundred years old when his son Isaac was born to him. 6 And Sarah said, "God has made me laugh, and all who hear will laugh with me." 7 She also said, "Who would have said to Abraham that Sarah would nurse children? For I have borne him a son in his old age."

The first son of promise entered the world to much _____ and fanfare. Since his parents were well beyond childbearing years his birth brought **special** blessings. Isaac enters the world to rich parents.
